DOG POLICY

In general, regulations regarding animals in the Market comply with RDN Policy on animals in public spaces. The Errington Farmers Market Society has jurisdiction on this topic during Market Hours (10:00am – 1:00pm on Saturdays from the first weekend in May to the last weekend in September).

- Vendors are not permitted to bring their dog to their stall/table.
- Customer's dogs must be on a leash and under control at all times. (short leash, close to owner)
- Other animals which are occasionally brought by customers as a special attraction (past examples include parrots, giant tortoise, heritage birds, goats) must be controlled by the owner at all times.
- N.B. **Customers must ensure that their dog avoids contact with vendor products. Dogs should be kept a reasonable distance from stalls/tables with food products. Both vendors and the Market Manager will enforce this expectation. Vendors may request the assistance of the Manager in dealing with dog complaints.**
- Any breech of this policy may result in the customer being asked to remove their dog
 from the Market immediately and /or the customer held financially responsible for any
 damage to goods or to the vendor display (e.g. customer will purchase spoiled
 vegetables, customer will replace damaged table covering, etc.)
